For the past few weeks the food industry has been subject to high profile food labelling and integrity issues.

Thomas Ridley Foodservice are contacting and working with our current suppliers to ensure all products meet industry guidelines.

We are currently in the process of establishing DNA testing regimes for all processed meat products supplied to us by manufacturers.

It is a requirement of our own due diligence demands, that we pursue our suppliers in this respect to reassure our customer base of product integrity on our product range in this category.

Thomas Ridley Foodservice will monitor the current situation regarding any further announcements from the Food Standards Agency.

Furthermore, we are committed to informing our customers should any of these issues affect the current products supplied.
